



## HASD Music Boosters' Music Scholarship Information

New to our scholarship offerings this year, the HASD Music Boosters are proud to announce scholarships for programs that occur during the school year (i.e. Lawrence Academy, Appleton Boys Choir, etc.). This does not include private music lessons. We will also continue to provide scholarships for summer music camps. These scholarships will be available for students in grades K-12. A number of area colleges offer summer music camps to students in grades K-12. **Please ask your music teachers for the information about the various camps and music programs that are available. They will have the brochures regarding them and can also direct you to any websites that may be available for more information.**

We are very fortunate here in the Hortonville Area School District to have a strong Music Booster organization. The Music Boosters help in a number of ways throughout the school year. One area is in the form of fundraising to generate scholarship money. The amount of scholarship money available depends on the support and participation of the music students, parents, relatives, and friends. The amount, also, varies yearly depending on the number of applicants. If students are interested in receiving scholarship money, they need to complete the scholarship application and return it to the address below by **April 15, 2012: (They must be postmarked by April 15, 2012.)**

We will then consider each request and assign scholarship monies to help reduce the cost of the camp or program. **If you are selected to receive a Music Booster Scholarship, the check will be made out to your selected camp or program.** The balance of the music camp or program costs will need to be paid by your family. The scholarship money will be delivered to your teacher by April 15<sup>th</sup>. If this conflicts with your registration deadline for your particular camp or music program, please contact Tracy Heimmermann (757-1496). The awarded music scholarship money will be distributed according to the following criteria:

1. Dedication to music (practice/effort/attitude)
2. What have you given back to your music community (helped at Silent Auction, donated baked goods, helped with other events)
3. Participation in music events
4. Level of achievement/desire
5. Student's comments listed on the HASD Music Boosters' Scholarship Application.
6. Financial need

Again, this year the Music Boosters have decided to award a ***SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP*** to one music student based on music staff recommendation, financial need, and the evaluation of your application. Completing this application allows the student to be considered for this award automatically.
