The nonresident district may bill actual, additional, special education cost to resident district. | Parents responsible for transportation, unless transportation is required in student's IEP.<br><br>Transportation provisions identical to those for open enrollment. State transportation reimbursement is available to low-income parents. |
| Senior Rule   | Nonresident District    | No aid transfer.  | Nonresident district provides special education, including IEP-required transportation. May not bill cost to resident district.  | Parents responsible for transportation, unless transportation is required in student's IEP.<br><br>State transportation reimbursement is not available.   |
