

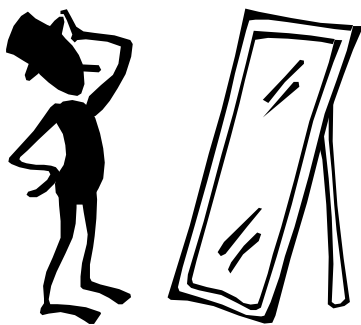
CSI: Me Final Reflection Paper
