Eligibility for the Hope Clinic is income at or below 300% of federal poverty. To check if you qualify go to www.hopeclinic.care/eligibility

During this changing time, the Hope Clinic is planning to:

- Remain open 9-5 M-Th
- Continue to re-fill medications for existing patients, address follow-ups via telemedicine process
- Triage all calls, give instruction and direction accordingly
- Serve those who need healthcare that is in our capability to have a Provider see via telemedicine by appointment
- Ask all individuals with coughs, sore or scratchy throats, fever and difficulty breathing to remain quarantined and treat with Tylenol and fluids

Important Information for Patients or Individuals seeking healthcare:

- If you begin experiencing an increase in difficulty breathing with a cough and fever, call your local Emergency Department for direction
- Hope Clinic will not take any walk-ins until further notice
- Hope Clinic does not administer the COVID-19 Test

If you are not familiar to the Hope Clinic, we may ask you to consult your regular PCP first.

Please be aware that Hope Clinic may not be able to make a diagnosis or treat all cases over the phone. You may be asked to seek further care as deemed appropriate by the provider.
