My mom April, was born March 28th, 1974 to Doug and Jacklyn Kuehne. As a child, she was very popular and was a girly girl, she loved cheerleading and had a lot of friends! She had a huge obsession with shoes.

My mom found out she had stage 2 ovarian cancer, she got cancer for the first time in 2006. Soon after, she had a partial hysterectomy, soon after the cancer went away. This lasted only a year. In 2007, she had my little brother. Then in 2008, she got stage 1 ovarian cancer; this time she only had it for six months before the treatment cleared the cancer.

The second time my mom had cancer it wasn't as bad because she had a partial hysterectomy. She had chemo but it wasn't an intense chemo treatment she never lost any of her hair, she lost very little weight (5-7 pounds at the most). My mom is a very strong woman and I love her for that.

My mom started getting stomach problem around the time of my parents divorce which was around 2010. It started with bleeding ulcers. The Doctors removed the bleeding ulcers and half of her stomach. My mom had a feeding tube and a central line, which goes to your heart, My mom had the feeding tube in for about two years. She lost a lot of weight because she could not eat, and would vomit every time she ate, she weighed 73 pounds and she was in her early 40s, she stayed the same for about Three mores years. In her fifth year of her being sick and the doctors don't having any idea of why she is sick. The amount of medicine my mom took would kill a 300 pound man, keep in mind she was only 73 pounds. Moving ahead, a couple of months, my mom started slowly taking herself off of her medicine, she was doing really well now she. But in gained a few pounds.

On October 15th, my grandma found my mom unconscious on the ground, so she took her to the hospital. My brothers and my dad and I, went and visited her for a the rest of the night we stayed with her until midnight. We didn't go to the school the next day because she had a seizure around 4:00 in the morning. We went there to see her because we weren't surprised for what was about what was about to happen. The doctor came in and told us the news she had seven blood clots a heart

disease and more that I can not remember. As a family we talked and we decided to talk her off of life support. She lost her fight on October 16th and around 1:30pm.
