

The *Final* Senior Checklist

Fall:

- Meet with your high school counselor
- Keep track of application dates and deadlines, scholarships and housing
- Submit applications and payments/waivers
- Request transcripts to be sent to colleges/universities through Xello**
- Attend financial aid workshops with parents/guardians
- Complete financial aid applications – FAFSA and local scholarship forms**
- Begin to apply for scholarships
- Sign-up for visits with college representatives or military recruiters
- Plan on retaking ACT to improve score if needed
- Take ACCUPLACER if needed for technical college(s)
- Explore Start College Now (SCN)/Early College Credit Program (ECCP)
- Update resume
- Register for AP tests in May

Winter:

- Decide which college or university you will attend next fall
- If required, pay your enrollment deposit
- Complete housing application

- Watch your email for campus updates
- Register for college placement tests
- Apply for scholarships
- Notify all other colleges to which you have been accepted, letting them know that you plan NOT to attend

Spring:

- Upload and have hours approved in Transeo** (<https://app.gotranseo.com/login/hortonville>) by April 15
- Admissions will be looking at your grades for your last semester, too. Finish strong!
- Take placement tests
- Review financial aid offer(s) from future campus
- Send final grades from your senior year to campus you'll be attending by requesting your transcript be sent through Xello***
- Sign up for student orientation at your future campus
- If military bound, finalize appropriate paperwork with your selected branch
- If work force bound, begin applying and interviewing for immediate employment upon graduation

Summer:

- Attend student orientation
- Get prepared for freshman year
