

**HORTONVILLE AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT  
BOARD OF EDUCATION REGULAR SPECIAL SESSION MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2010**

1. The Board of Education Special Session was called to order by President Thome at 6:00 p.m. All Board members were present for roll call and for the duration of the meeting – Craig Dreier, Willard Griesbach, Bill Murphy, Marv Obry, Jim Richards, Paul Thome and Bob Van Den Elzen.
2. President Thome confirmed that the public was given notice of the meeting by postings at Greenville Elementary, Hortonville Elementary, Greenville Middle, Hortonville Middle and Hortonville High schools; Hortonville Public Library and the District website ([www.hasd.org](http://www.hasd.org)). Notice of the meeting and agenda was also sent to the Appleton Post Crescent, Post Crescent West and County Post East.
3. Mr. Obry made a motion to approve the 2010-11 District Budget. Mr. Van Den Elzen seconded the motion. Mr. Obry withdrew the motion and Mr. Van Den Elzen withdrew the second so that the Board of Education could consider the 2011 tax levy prior to the voting on the 2010-11 District Budget.
4. Mr. Obry made a motion to approve the 2011 tax levy of \$15,246,088 with a mil rate of \$9.03. Mr. Dreier seconded the motion. After a discussion of the tax levy by the Board members, Mr. Thome called for roll call vote. Mr. Obry, Mr. Dreier, Mr. Griesbach, Mr. Van Den Elzen and Mr. Thome voted yes; Mr. Richards and Mr. Murphy voted no; motion carried.
5. Mr. Van Den Elzen made a motion to approve a 2010-11 Combined District Revenue Budget of \$39,865,866 and a District Combined Expenditure Budget of \$39,909,941 to cover Funds 10, 21, 27, 29, 39, 50 and 80. Mr. Griesbach seconded the motion. Mr. Van Den Elzen, Mr. Griesbach, Mr. Obry, Mr. Dreier and Mr. Thome voted yes; Mr. Richards and Mr. Murphy voted no; motion carried.
6. Mr. Obry made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Griesbach seconded the motion; unanimous vote; motion carried.
7. With no further business, President Thome adjourned the meeting and 6:45 p.m.
