

**HORTONVILLE AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION SPECIAL SESSION MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, APRIL 25, 2011**

1. With the absence of the President and Vice President, the Board of Education Special Session was called to order by Board Clerk Obry at 7:00 p.m. Board members were present for roll call and for the duration of the meeting – Craig Dreier, Willard Griesbach, Marv Obry and Jim Richards. Bill Murphy, Paul Thome and Bob Van Den Elzen were excused.

Mr. Jeff Brightwell, Alternative Education Teacher, and Mr. Tim Diestler, Director of Facilities, also addressed budgeted items pertaining to the Hortonville High School complex.
8. Mr. Jason Hurley, Activities Director, presented an overview of the HHS Athletic Budget and answered questions from the Board.
9. The overview of the Special Education Personnel was tabled for the May 9th Special Session.
10. Mr. Tim Diestler, Director of Facilities, presented an overview of maintenance and facilities of the District and answered questions from the Board.
11. Mr. Harry Steenbock, Director of Transportation, presented an overview of the transportation budget and answered questions from the Board. He also gave a brief update on the bus fleet.
