Policy Statement:

The District was created by order of the County School Committee on July 1, 1963, consisting of the Village of Hortonville, towns or parts of towns of Hortonia, Dale, Ellington, Liberty, Greenville, Center and Grand Chute. The formal name of the school district was changed at the Annual Meeting of September 23, 2002 from "School District of Hortonville" to "Hortonville Area School District". A detailed map of District is available for viewing in the offices of the District Administrator, Director of Business Services, Director of Transportation and the offices of all school buildings.

Rationale:

The boundaries of the school district are defined in order to establish residency and administer property tax allocation for school purposes.

Scope: District-wide

Responsibility: Board of Education

Implementation:

All changes to the boundaries of the school district must adhere to the school district reorganization procedure specified in Chapter 117 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.
