Policy Statement:

The Board of Education is responsible for the management of all affairs of the school district and should not be influenced by opportunities for personal or professional gain.

Rationale:

The school district is a public entity. All decisions should reflect the interest of the entire school district community.

Scope: District-wide

Responsibility: Board of Education

Implementation:

1. During the term for which he/she is elected or appointed, no Board of Education member shall engage, as a private person, in any business transaction with the school district, except as provided by Wisconsin Statutes 946.13(2).
2. The Board shall not draw or cause to be drawn, or accept, a specification for any item to be purchased by the District corporation, partnership, or other business entity of which a Board of Education member is an officer, agent, or employee to the exclusion of all other persons who could submit quotations or bids of an equivalent item.
3. Board members shall avoid any appearance of conflict between the interests of the District and their own or that of their families.
4. No member of the Board of Education, shall act as a petitioner, intervenor or attorney on behalf of any member of his immediate family in the matter of discipline of a student by personnel of the District.
