Policy Statement:

Wisconsin State Statutes describe all powers and duties of the Board of Education.

Rationale:

Wisconsin State Statutes indicates all school districts are governed by a local, elected Board of Education with powers as written below.

Scope: District-wide

Responsibility: Board of Education

Implementation:

Power and Duty of the Board of Education

The powers and duties of the Board of Education shall be conferred and prescribed by law. Complete and final control as to all matters pertaining to the educational system shall be and are statute vested in the Board of Education.

In the interpretation of the power and duties of the Board, it is understood that the Board shall act as a legislative body in determining the general policies for the control, operation, maintenance and expansion of the public schools of the Hortonville Area School District.

The execution of these policies, as set forth by the Board, shall be the responsibility of the superintendent and his administrative staff
