**Policy Statement:**

Children ages 0-3 with developmental delays are encouraged to receive intervention at an early age.

**Rationale:**

Early intervention may be successful in treating/eradicating a variety of behaviors that will often cause the child to be more successful in an educational experience.

**Scope:** District-wide

**Responsibility:** Director of Special Education

**Implementation:**

Any child below the age of three with a suspected learning handicap will be automatically referred to the Outagamie County Early Intervention Program for evaluation and that organization will assume total responsibility for evaluating the child.

Service will not be provided to children by public schools until the child attains the age of 3.
