POLICY STATEMENT:

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of intercultural and international education as an important part of a school program.

The School District of Hortonville does not discriminate against pupils on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap in its education programs or activities.

RATIONALE:

SCOPE: District-wide

RESPONSIBILITY:

Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of the administrators with the assistance of the Guidance Department.

IMPLEMENTATION:

The Board presently approves the following exchange programs: American Field Service and Youth for Understanding, and Others:

1. The number of exchange students shall not exceed three (3) during any one school year.
2. It shall be the policy of the Board to waive tuition for exchange students living in home within the District provided the particular exchange program is under recognized and responsible sponsorship and has had prior Board approval.
3. The school shall be notified of a possible enrollment no later than May 1st of the previous school year. Failure of this notification may mean the enrollment will be denied.
4. Special classroom fees, lunch monies, and special event fees or needs will be the responsibility of the student, their parents or sponsors.
