Policy Statement:

Smoking and all tobacco use is not permitted on public school property, including school buses, at anytime.

Rationale:

It has long been established that smoking is the single most preventable cause of premature death and disability in the country. A tobacco-free school environment decreases health risks for school district employees and students and also helps provide students with positive non-smoking role models. .

Scope: District-wide

Responsibility: All Administrators

Implementation:

The use of all tobacco-related products (smoking and smokeless products) are banned from use on District property, property used for District activities and inside all District buildings.

This ban is for students, District employees and the general public. In addition to the above, the use of tobacco products by students is not permitted when they are a representative of the school in a school-sponsored activity.
