POLICY STATEMENT:

School lockers are the property of the School District of Hortonville. At no time does the School District of Hortonville relinquish its exclusive control of lockers provided for the convenience of students. Periodic general inspections of lockers may be conducted by school authorities for any reason at any time, without notice, without student consent and without a search warrant.

RATIONALE:

The provision of lockers is a privilege and convenience granted to the students by the District.

SCOPE:

All students within the School District of Hortonville.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of all administrators.

IMPLEMENTATION:

High School and Middle School

Assignments are made to students of book lockers when they enter Middle School and High School. At that time each student is required to place a padlock deposit with the School Office. This deposit is returned to the student at the completion of Middle School or High School, provided there is no damage to the padlock. Only padlocks distributed by the School may be used with the assigned locker.

Elementary Schools

Lockers assigned by the Elementary Schools require no padlock.


Lockers under the supervision of the Physical Education Department are assigned on a seasonal basis by the Instructors. Lockers under the supervision of the Athletic Department are assigned by the Coaches and students are required to pay a deposit fee for a padlock.

Under no circumstance is the School District of Hortonville responsible for the loss or theft of items from lockers.


