Policy Statement:

The Hortonville Area School District provides special education services for all students in accordance with state and federal laws.

Rationale:

The Hortonville Area School District provides free appropriate public education to all children with disabilities.

Scope: All children ages 3-21 years within the Hortonville Area School District.

Responsibility:

Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of the District Administrator, Director of Special Education and all Building Administrators.

Implementation:

1. The school district will conduct evaluations of children suspected of having a disability and provide special education services for all eligible children in accordance with state and federal laws adhering to due process safeguards for parents' rights and appeal.
2. Procedures for special education evaluation and Individual Educational Program (IEP) development are given to building administrators and special education staff annually.
3. The Hortonville Area School District has available to all of its children with disabilities the variety of educational programs and services available to non-disabled children in the school district.
4. The Hortonville Area School District provides nonacademic and extra-curricular services and activities that afford children with disabilities an equal opportunity for participation.
