Policy Statement:

The School District of Hortonville will allow students who are home schooled the opportunity to participate in non-core academic classes, including but not limited to art, music, physical education, and co-curricular activities excluding athletics, provided there is space available in the course or activity and/or the teacher/student ratio will be within reason for the District.

Rationale:

Wisconsin Attorney General's opinion (OAG 45-86) allows a school district to accept home school students in co-curricular activities and non-core academic classes. WIAA regulations state that member schools will not accept home schooled students in athletics if they are not on a school's roster for state aid.

When space is available, the District hopes to improve educational opportunities for all students.

Scope: K-12

Responsibility:

Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of Building Administrators

Implementation:

1. Prior to a semester or the beginning of the school year, a written request must be made to the Building Administrator by the parent/guardian of the home schooled child to attend non-academic core classes and/or co-curricular activities.
2. Written requests must be made for each semester.
3. The privilege is contingent upon adherence to the rules and policies of the School District of Hortonville.
4. Written approval will be granted prior to the second week of any semester.
5. Students are responsible for transportation and all course fees.
