Policy Statement:

The policy of the Hortonville School District is setting high expectations of students, and for the students achieving high expectations. Should a student not meet a passing grade in any course, the student will be offered remediation with support from administration and teaching staff. Failure to achieve a passing grade in any course before the last day of Summer School will result in retention in the current grade.

Rationale:

Students need to be held responsible for missing work. It is not "OK" to get an F in a class and just move on to the next grade. If for whatever reason, a student has failed any class during a quarter, the student is expected to remediate his/her failing grade(s) before the last day of Summer School.

Students who are held accountable for making up failed work will learn the organizational and motivational skills necessary to successfully complete future school and job assignments.

Scope: Students in grades 6-8

Responsibility: Middle School Administration/Teaching Staff

Implementation:

1. Students who receive one or more F's in any class at the end of a quarter are identified.
2. Students meet with administration/guidance counselor and contract for up to two weeks to remediate the failing grade(s) independently by completing a portfolio of work. If the student completes remediated portfolio work satisfactorily, the original grade of F will be changed to a D-.
3. If not remediated, student participates in after school remediation. If portfolio is satisfactorily completed, grade(s) is/are changed to D-.
4. If not remediated, student participates in Saturday School. If portfolio is satisfactorily completed, grade(s) is/are changed to D-.
5. If not remediated, student participates in Summer School. If portfolio is satisfactorily completed, grade(s) is/are changed to D-.
6. If student has not remediated the failing grade(s) before the end of the last day of Summer School, student is retained.
