POLICY STATEMENT:

Various resources may be used to address the Board of Education adopted curriculum. Committee selected and recommended resources that have been approved for adoption by the Board of Education serve as the primary vehicle for delivering the written curriculum.

RATIONALE:

Using selected resources that are congruent with the curriculum provides all students, regardless of instructor, the opportunity to understand concepts and master skills that are essential to the next level of learning.

SCOPE: All K-12 classroom teachers.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Compliance with this policy shall be the responsibility of classroom teachers, building administrators and the curriculum director.

IMPLEMENTATION:

Resources, often times being textbooks, are evaluated in terms of their ability to help students understand concepts and master skills that are identified in a particular guide as "goals and objectives". Resources that have been selected as the best overall tool for this purpose, whether within or between grade levels, provide a framework within which appropriate and desired units and lessons are designed.

All units or lessons will be consistent with the curriculum as adopted with the Board of Education. With primary consideration being given to the use of adopted materials, additional materials can be incorporated at the discretion of the instructor.
