HHS School Employee Wellness Award – Binder of application was circulated. A summary of the application was presented and the application was submitted.

Staff Wellness Stipends – Each building has \$300 to be used for staff wellness and \$500 for the District Employee Wellness. Grant applications will be due to Sandy Schulz by Jan. 21.
