Dear Families,

We are nearing the end of the first quarter of the school year, and our classroom economy is up and running. The students are operating on a cash-based system of payment and incentives for being responsible students and holding classroom jobs while using saving accounts as well as paying fees, fines, and even rent; we will be starting checking accounts and even taxes in the near future!

This year's first **LUNDSTROM-LAND AUCTION DAY** is Thursday, October 21! During the auction, students are able to auction off various items to be sold for "L-bucks" (our classroom currency) to the highest bidder. *Each student that wishes to participate in auctioning off items must have a signed auction permission slip to verify that Mom/Dad or responsible adult understands the basics of our classroom auction.*

With your permission, your son or daughter may bring items that he or she would like to auction off for the auction on **Thursday**, **October 21**. Each student may auction off up to 3 "lots," which are items or groups of items that are sold together. Examples of items to be considered might be small inexpensive trinkets, small toys, games, stuffed animals, books, and other "student desirable" items. Food such as cookies, juice, soda, snacks, chips, and fruit may also be sold at our auction, but please keep healthy food choices in mind if you are helping your student decide.
