Dear Parents,

It is time to begin another chapter in the adventure of life. I feel privileged to be a part of this new journey. Mrs. Jones, your child's social studies teacher, the exploratory teachers, and the other students in our class will be important players.

Attached is a schedule of your child's school day. It's possible for there to be changes from the original copy you received at registration. Third and fourth periods are left blank so that you may fill in your own child's individual schedule for specials and exploratories. These classes run on a two day rotation. That means that the first day of school we will be on Day 1 (A Day) and the third day we will have same exploratory classes as the first day of school. The exploratory class schedule will change at semester to accommodate a total of 6 exploratory classes for the year.

Student's lunch numbers will remain the same as last year. Lunch money needs to be in an envelope, labeled with student's name and lunch number. These envelopes are placed in a box in the commons near the computer lab door either before school or at lunch time. The deposit will show on the account the following day.

Your child's assignment notebook is an important communication tool. For the first several weeks of school, I ask that your child show you his/her assignment book and have you initial it **daily**. There should be something written for each subject each day even if there is no assignment. You may wish to check the calendar on Skyward if they forget to fill out the assignment book. There is also a space provided where you can write any comments or questions for me. Please remind your child to show me these notes. I check assignment books often but not daily. Students are encouraged to use assignment books to keep track of after school activities i.e. lessons, practices, and special events as well as class assignments. Please reinforce that it will help him/her to organize, prioritize, and manage time. Notice, too, that there are reference pages for your child's use and a GMS student handbook.

Middle school is an exciting challenge in your child's life. Together we can make this school year a positive experience. Please feel free to contact me whenever a question or concern arises. Like you, I also enjoy hearing positive news so let's keep in touch.
