

I can identify masculine & feminine nouns (gender).
We know that all nouns in Spanish have <u>number</u> & <u>gender</u> .
How do I know if a noun is <u>masculine</u> or <u>feminine</u> ? NOT QUITE SO EASY
1. Think about the <u>meaning</u> of the word.
if the definition of the word refers to a boy or a man (son, brother, father, etc.), the noun is <u>masculine</u> .
If the definition of the word refers to a girl or a woman (daughter, sister, mother, etc.), the noun is
2. Look at the ending of the word. Masculine nouns often but NOT always end in L.O.N.E.R.S.
Feminine nouns often but NOT always end D. ión Z.A.
HOWEVER, there are some nouns that do not follow a pattern at all. It is VERY IMPORTANT to know each noun's gender. So, if you cannot determine a noun's gende using one of the above 2 strategies, you will need to look the noun up on your vocab lise = masculine, = feminine.
You will need to memorize the gender of these "tricky" ones.
