
## Los pronombres sujetos singulares



As you can see, there are 2 singular forms of "you".

informal/familiar	formal
tú	usted (Ud.)
<ul> <li>People you know well</li> <li>friends</li> <li>peers</li> <li>family/relatives younger than you</li> <li>a child</li> <li>pets</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>People you don't know well</li> <li>Someone you would adress by their title (Sr., Sra., Srta., Dr., Dra., ect.)</li> <li>Athority figures</li> <li>Someone you know, but you're not close to</li> <li>Elders</li> <li>Family/Relatives older than you</li> </ul>

Not only is <u>Usted</u> formal, but is used to **show respect**.
