FRECUENTEMENTE	frequently	70%									
GENERALMENTE	generally	80%									
TODOS LOS DÍAS	every day	100%

There are some "tricks" to help you remember where to place various adverbs of frequency in Spanish.

• The first three (Siempre, Nunca, and Rara vez) are placed directly before the verb.

The other six can be placed either <u>at the beginning</u> or <u>at the end</u>

of a sentence, but **NEVER** in the middle of a sentence!
