Cultural fact:

Typically, dinner is very late in Spanish speaking countries.

## Saludos=Greeting

anytime	Day break until or before lunch	After lunch or 12:00pm until before dinner.	After dinner until bedtime.
			
<b>Hola.</b> <b>Hello</b>	<b>Buenos días.</b> <b>Good morning.</b>	<b>Buenas tardes.</b> <b>Good afternoon.</b>	<b>Buenas noches.</b> <b>Good evening.</b>

## Courtesies=Courtesies

Mucho gusto.	<b>Nice to meet you.</b>	El gusto es mío.	<i>Nice to meet you too.</i>
Encantado / a.	<b>Delighted (enchanted) to meet you.</b>	Igualmente.	<i>Likewise. / Same here. Nice to meet you too.</i>
*Es mi placer.	<b>It's my pleasure.</b>	*El placer es mío.	<i>The pleasure is mine.</i>

Es mi amigo...**My friend is**...(insert the name of the person you are introducing)

\*Te presento a....→ **I (would like to) present you to**...(insert the name of the person you are introducing)

## Despedidas=Farewells or Leave-takings.

<b>Adiós.</b>	<b>Good bye.</b>	Most common farewell. Used anytime.
<b>Nos vemos.</b>	<b>See you. / We'll see you.</b>	May see each other in a few days.
<b>Hasta luego.</b>	<b>See you later. Until later.</b>	The same day.
<b>Hasta pronto.</b>	<b>See you soon. Until soon.</b>	Soon
<b>Hasta mañana.</b>	<b>See you tomorrow. Until tomorrow.</b>	Tomorrow
<b>Hasta siempre.</b>	<b>See you. / Good bye forever.</b>	May never see each other again.
<b>*Hasta la vista.</b>	<b>See you.</b>	<b>Least common farewell.</b> May see each other occasionally.

\*These phrases are nice to know, so they will not be required for testing.
