

# Washington D.C. Packing List

5 Full Days (Wednesday and Sunday are travel days)

Typical DC weather this time of the year has highs of mid 60's to lows in the morning and evenings of low 50's. Layers are a must.

## Recommended List (\*Optional)

- 3-4 pants
- 4 long sleeve shirts
- 2 sweatshirts or fleece
- 1 jacket (rain tolerant designed to bring the wind)
- Stocking hat
- Mittens or gloves (seriously? Yes seriously!)
- 2 PAIRS OF THE MOST COMFORTABLE SHOE YOU OWN FOR MILES OF WALKING Tennis shoes preferred (wear one to school, pack 1 other pair in case these get wet)
- 4 pairs of underwear
- 4-6 pairs of socks
- 2-3 pajamas
- Small toiletries (soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, deodorant) Guidelines listed on the next page
- Chapstick (salty, ocean air chaps lips)
- Toothbrush
- \*Hairbrush/comb
- \*Hair supplies (ties, headbands)
- \*Prescription medicine(Please give to Mr. Hall prior to leaving)
- \*Glass/contact supplies (no large bottles of contact cleaner)
- \*Cell phone
- \*Cell Phone charger(Please label the cord and wall plug)
- \*Portable charger to provide a midday boost to your cell phone
- \*Chargers for any other electronic
- \*Small umbrella
- \*Baseball cap
- \*Money for souvenirs and snacks
- \*Water bottle

## **Luggage:**

Students will have 2 carry on bags. One must be the orange backpack provided by FWA and the other should be luggage that can be stored in the overhead compartment. Also, it should be noted that all bags will need to be carried from the DC airport onto the subway and from the subway station to the house. It is highly recommended to have a bag with wheels and is relatively lightweight...don't overpack. It is a 0.7 mile walk (15 minutes) from the subway to our house. Your carry-on bag's dimensions, including handles and wheels, can't exceed 9.5" height + 15.5" width + 24" length, and the bag can't weigh more than 35 pounds. Your carry-on bag must fit underneath the seat or in an enclosed overhead bin.

- **3-1-1 for carry-ons** = 3.4 ounce (100ml) bottle or less (by volume); 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; 1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin. One-quart bag per person limits the total liquid volume each traveler can bring. 3.4 ounce (100ml) container size is a security measure.
