Students Served:

7th and 8th grade students

Description:

Coaches work toward developing football players. They decide players' positions and playing time in games based on practice time, ability, dedication, size, attitude, and willingness to learn.

Time Period:

The season is usually set in late summer / early fall, and is posted in the GMS newsletter. Players will receive a copy once the season is underway. Approximately 5 games are played, beginning in mid September and ending in mid October.

Practice overview:

Practice may start a few days before the first day of school in order to handle physical cards, uniform issue, etc. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from GMS on these days. Players are expected to attend practices, and urged to check into alternative times for other activities. Per WIAA regulations, a player needs eight practices before the first game. Players must purchase their own cleats, and have a physical card turned into the office prior to any practice.

Students travel to away games, located in Wautoma, Clintonville, and Oconto Falls.
