Focus on the Children Free Dental Screening and Fluoride Varnish Program

The Hortonville Area School District, in collaboration with the Tri-County Community Dental Clinic, is pleased to offer the "Focus on Children" Program. If your preschool, kindergarten, and/or elementary school student receives **free or reduced cost hot lunch** he/she is qualified to participate in a free dental screening and fluoride varnish program.

On February 29, 2011, from 8 – 11:30 a.m. the dental screening team will be at Greenville Elementary School and from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. the program will be set up at Hortonville Elementary. This is for all children grades 4K through 5th grade who receive free or reduced cost hot lunch. If your child qualifies, the following forms need to be completed and returned to your child's school office:

- Dental Consent Form (required with health concerns, permissions, insurance, etc.),
- Photo/Interview Release Form, and
- Sharing Information with Other Programs Form

These forms are available at each school's office as well as on our school district website- <http://www.hasd.org/district/Health.cfm> . The forms are due back in the office by Monday, February 20, 2012. Services cannot be offered to your child without the completion and office review of these forms. Program Description

Phase I (takes place in your child's school)

Dental health screening

Dental hygienist will:

Screen and record the student's general oral health

Apply fluoride varnish immediately

Phase II (takes place at Tri-County Community Dental Clinic)

Dental Hygienist will:

Clean your child's teeth

Place sealants if appropriate

Apply fluoride varnish

Dentist will do a thorough examination of your child's teeth

Children requiring restorative treatment will be put into a schedule for Phase III

Children who are cavity free will be scheduled for a six month repeat of Phase II

Phase III (takes place at Tri-County Community Dental Clinic)

A volunteer dentist will provide the necessary restorative treatment your child requires

If your child receives free or reduced cost hot lunch the above services and treatment are provided at No-Charge
