## SUMMER SCHOOL REMEDIATION!

Summer school will begin on Thursday, June 9 – July 5 from 8:00-12:00 at GMS for any student in grade 6-8 that has not remediated failed classes for quarters 1, 2, 3 or received a failing grade for fourth quarter. There will be no summer school on Monday, July 4th. To date we have sixteen students needing to remediate classes for quarter 1 or 2,

and twenty-five students for quarter 3.

Students will be notified verbally and in writing of their enrollment in summer school before the last day of school. Parents will soon receive an initial letter of assignment to summer school. Remediation folders for fourth quarter will be distributed in summer school on June 9th. Once a stu-

dent successfully remediates all failed classes they no longer need to attend summer school.

Parents and students in grades 6-8 are again reminded that failure to successfully remediate all failed classes by the last day of summer school will result in retention in the same grade.

Mrs. Montour and Mrs. Patch will be at the school meeting with students individually to help them decide which instrument is best suited for them. All interested students will be called down by class. Parents are welcome to attend but please give us a day’s notice to schedule an approximate time.

**May 23<sup>rd</sup> 6:30 pm** - **Parent Informational Meeting** - at Greenville Middle School. This is your chance to learn more about the Greenville Middle School Band Program. Both band directors will be available for questions.

The decision to be in band is a big one. Band requires a high level of commitment from both the student and the parents. As you are deciding whether or not band is for you, please keep the following in mind: **At GMS, starting in 6<sup>th</sup> Grade, students MUST take band or choir. 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Band is a prerequisite for taking band in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. NOW is the time to join—due to the size and structure of the program, students who do not take band in 5<sup>th</sup> grade will NOT be able to start in 6<sup>th</sup> grade.**
