PreK-9th Grade Registration

Course Dates and Locations (Please note that all courses will be held at the Hortonville campus this year):

- Classes are held: June 10– June 28 and will run from 8:00am to 12:00pm
- Elementary classes will be held at **Hortonville Elementary School**
- Middle school classes will be held at **Hortonville Middle School**

Free Greenville Shuttle Bus to Hortonville Elementary and Hortonville Middle School:

There will be a free shuttle bus that will run daily. The bus will transport any student enrolled in PK-8 summer school classes. It will run each morning of the program. Parents may sign up in Skyward by selecting “Yes” for summer school transportation. Students who have signed up for the summer school shuttle should plan on being at their pickup location (either GES or NGES) prior to 7:40 as the shuttle will be leaving at 7:40. The bus will be parked at the front of the school for GES and the parking lot/front of the school for NGES. Students who are riding the shuttle will then return to GES or NGES by 12:20 so parents/guardians should be there to meet their child. Just a reminder that there is no supervision for students who are waiting for the shuttle. If you have any questions, please contact Kari Rankin. Registration

Registration for students that have a **referral** to summer school begins on Friday, March 1 to Monday March 11, 2024. School staff will register you in those classes.

Registration for **all** students entering grades 4K-9 begins on Monday, March 18th at 9 a.m. and will close on May 3, 2024 at 8:00 am.

Registration for summer school will be online through **the parent’s Skyward account**. A [tutorial](#) is available at the HASD summer school website (visit www.hasd.org and click on the summer school link). After logging into the parent Skyward account, you will select “Arena Scheduling” on the left sidebar. The classes that are available for your child’s grade level and what is currently open will show on the Skyward screen to help you choose the class for your child. Please be sure all referrals/recommendation papers from classroom teacher are sent to the Summer School Coordinator through any HASD school office.

If you don’t have internet access, you may register at any school location regardless of where your child attends during the school year.

Fee Information

Summer School Fees can be dropped off or mailed to any school location. Checks can be made payable to the school at which you drop off the payment. We do reserve the right to drop students from classes if fees are NOT paid by the 1st day of summer school.

Registration Disclaimers

- Student and class schedules are subject to change due to class size and interest.
- Class size is limited and many classes fill quickly.
- Students will be registered on a first-come, first-serve basis (we do not have a waiting list).
- Referral Classes- Student referrals for math and reading and Learning Behaviors/Playground Skills courses will have **first priority enrollment**. If openings exist following referral registration, they are first come-first served.
- Registration closes **May 3, 2024 at 8:00am**.

Entering 4K - Kindergarten Course Descriptions

Alphabet Fun (Grades: 4K – K): No Cost

Description: Students will have fun learning a new letter each day. They will learn the sound/s the letter makes, how to properly form the letter, and be given opportunities to practice simple CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words containing that letter (verbal and written practice)

Bear Fun Summer (Grades: 4K – K): No Cost

Description: Students will explore Kindergarten readiness skills through bear books and a “hands-on” approach. Each class will include story-time, an activity related to the books read, as well as building skills necessary for kindergarten.

Craftin’ and Snackin’ (Grades: 4K – K): Cost \$5

Description: After reading a children’s book each day students will create a craft and enjoy a pre-packaged snack that coincides with the book.

Learning Behaviors and Playground Skills (Grades: 4K-1): No Cost (Referral only)

Description: Students will practice expected learning behaviors and social skills in classroom and playground settings. Students will engage in learning games and play with peers inside and on the playground. Positive reinforcement will be used to foster growth in and outside of the classroom setting.

Pre-Kindergarten Math (Grade: K): No Cost (Referral)

*****This class will be given to students having teacher and recommendations/referrals. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.***

Description: Students will actively explore mathematical concepts (numbers, dot card flashing, finger flashing) using concrete materials and practice early math skills and goals. This course will also include counting games, number sense activities, along with basic addition and subtraction. Teachers will adjust instruction to meet each child’s math skills.

Reading for Success (Grade: Pre-K Literacy): No Cost (Referral)

*****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.***

Description: Students will practice skills and goals in an intensive framework. This course will have fun read alouds, letter recognition, phonics games/activities and guided reading. Teachers will be adjusting instruction to meet the child’s reading level and needs. This class will primarily be focused on teaching student academics. The ratio of student to teacher will also be lower to provide the most individualized instruction possible.

Super Summer Safety (Grades: 4K-K): No Cost

Description: Students will be learning about good health and safety for themselves. Some of the topics covered will be: fire safety, bike safety, being safe in the sun, germs, personal hygiene and nutrition and fitness.

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Wonderful World of Words (Grades: K-2 & 3-5): No Cost

Description: **This is your open registration literacy class for incoming Kindergarteners!** Through stories, videos, crafts, games, technology, and more, students will learn and practice vocabulary words that are essential for school success. “General academic vocabulary” includes those words that students frequently encounter in school. Fun figurative language and word-learning strategies will be explored. Students can express their creativity by making their own dictionaries and word games. Also, each student will receive a grade specific list of essential academic vocabulary, so learning can continue over the summer. Come join us, and see how much fun words can be!

Entering Grades 1-5 Class Descriptions

Pre-First Reading (Grade: K): No Cost (Referral)

****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Description: Students will practice skills and goals in an intensive framework. This course will have fun read alouds, letter recognition, phonics games/activities and guided reading. Teachers will be adjusting instruction to meet the child's reading level and needs. This class will primarily be focused on teaching student academics. The ratio of student to teacher will also be lower to provide the most individualized instruction possible. This class is for incoming 1st graders only.

Reading for Success (Grades: 2–5): No Cost (Referral)

****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Description: Students will practice skills and goals in an intensive framework. This course will have fun read alouds, letter recognition, phonics games/activities and guided reading. Teachers will be adjusting instruction to meet the child's reading level and needs. This class will primarily be focused on teaching student academics. The ratio of student to teacher will also be lower to provide the most individualized instruction possible. Classes will be combined grades 2-3 and grades 4-5 with a separate grade 1.

Pre-First Math (Grade: 1): No Cost (Referral)

****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Description: Students going into first grade will actively explore mathematical concepts (addition, subtraction, dot card flashing) using concrete materials, counting games, ten frames, number paths and number sentences (number sense activities). Math fact strategies will be shared with Number Talks. Teachers will adjust instruction to meet each child's math skills.

Learning Behaviors and Playground Skills (Grades: 4K-1): No Cost (Referral only)

Description: Students will practice expected learning behaviors and social skills in classroom and playground settings. Students will engage in learning games and play with peers inside and on the playground. Positive reinforcement will be used to foster growth in and outside of the classroom setting.

Math for Success (Grades: 2-3): (Referral)

****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Description: This developmentally targeted, skill-focused, math class is designed to help students become more confident in their ability to master basic math skills. Students going into second grade will work on depth in addition, subtraction, and place value understanding using add/subtraction operations and two-digit numbers. Third grade will actively explore mathematical concepts (addition, subtraction, word problems, and place value) using concrete materials, ten frames, place value blocks, number sentences, and multiplying x4. Math fact strategies will be shared with Number Talks for both. Classes will be combined grades 2-3.

Math for Success (Grades: 4-5): (Referral)

****These classes will be given to students having teacher and reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Description: This developmentally targeted, skill-focused, math class is designed to help students explore mathematical concepts (place value, multiplication and division) using concrete materials, place value blocks, and number sentences. Math fact strategies will be shared with Number Talks. This active class is designed to help students become more confident in their ability to master basic math skills. Classes will be combined grades 4-5

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Emotional Regulation 101 (Grades 1-2, 3-4): No Cost

Students will learn their own body signals and calm down tools that can help their body feel good. Students will practice recognizing their own emotions and the emotions of others: learning how to respond when people have big emotions (strategies will include but not limited to: what is in your circle of control—does your reaction match the size of the problem).

Art Works (Grades: 1-3 & 4-5): Cost \$5

Description: Why not put an art adventure in your student's summer fun? In this session, kids will explore art materials, solve design challenges, and make cool stuff.

"Inside Out" Health/Physical Education Class (Grades: 2-3 & 4-5): No Cost

Description: Students will learn how to keep their growing bodies healthy inside and out. They will be learning the 5 components of wellness which are the backbones of optimal adolescent health. All learning will be done through interactive games (fun gym games) and hands on age-appropriate lessons that will keep all students engaged to help develop lifelong health habits. By the end of the 3 weeks, students will have the tools to understand their bodies "Inside Out"!

Bookin' and Cookin' (Grades: 1 – 2): Cost \$10

Description: After reading a children's book each day students will make a snack that coincides with the book. They will then enter into their recipe book their favorite part of the book and watch a video that coincides with the book.

Creative Writing (Grades: 3-4, 5-6): No Cost

Description: Students will extend their writing skills in new and exciting ways during this 3 week writing enrichment course! This course is perfect for students who love writing and want a challenge.

Educational Games Online (Grades: 2-3 & 4-5): No Cost

Description: Students will be shown how to engage in online academic games to enhance their math, science, reading and social studies skills. They will learn how to navigate through the internet safely and for educational purposes.

Learning through Board and Table Games (Grades: 2-3 & 4-5): No Cost

Description: Students will practice expected learning behaviors, social skills, and gamesmanship through a variety of board games. Each game played will be presented with the background of the game along with the rules that the students will understand and practice before game competition begins. All games will be age appropriate. Following the playing the board games, students develop and create their own board game using prior knowledge gained while playing.

Mad Scientist (Grades: 4-5): Cost \$5

Description: Students will perform experiments, both physical science and chemistry on a daily basis. The class emphasis will be on safety, the scientific method, and hands on learning in a lab setting. The activities in this course will be different each year.

Music is Fun (Grades: 1-2 & 3-5): No Cost

Description: Students will be doing circle games, musical literature, folk dancing, creating your own musical instruments, and more.

Number Fun for Everyone (Grades: 2-3): No Cost **This is a more challenging, open registration, class**

Description: This "up out of your seat and get active" class is designed to help students become more confident in their ability to **go beyond** the basic math skills and focus on problem solving and math applications that enhance math learning. Incoming second and third graders will actively explore mathematical concepts (addition, subtraction, and place value) using concrete materials, ten frames, place value blocks, and number sentences. Classes will be combined grades 2-3.

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Number Mania (Grades: 4-5): No Cost **This is a more challenging, open registration, class**

Description: Students going into fourth and fifth grade will actively explore mathematical concepts (place value, multiplication and division) using concrete materials, place value blocks, and number sentences. Enrichment activities along with mathematical problem solving and number sense approaches will help students become more confident in their ability to master beyond the basic math skills. Classes will be combined grades 4-5.

Outdoor Adventures (Grades K-1, 2-3): No Cost

Description: How would you like to be an outdoor/ocean explorer? In this class students will engage in activities centered around animals and their habitats. Students will participate in movement activities and will listen to stories related to the outdoors and the ocean. Students will explore the outdoors (around the school) and make observations regarding plants and animals. Students will create animal habitats and understand how plants and adults (including humans) can change the environment.

Sensational Success for Chocoholics (Grades: 5-6): \$5

Description: Looking to satisfy your fondness for chocolate? Well, we have the deal for you! Join the fun of experiencing sweet success while learning more about cocoa, and in the meantime upping your game of creating a chocolate masterpiece of your own. In addition, you will learn about local chocolate businesses, while exploring possible careers that connect you to your love of chocolate. Looking forward to a sweet time! *Those with nut allergies should be aware that chocolates used in class are made in a factory that also produces nuts.*

Spanish: A Summer Fiesta (Grades: 1-2, 3-5): No Cost

Description: Palm trees, pyramids, and piñatas...what do all these words have in common? SPANISH language and culture! Students will experience new content and cultural material not already found in the curriculum. Each level will focus on different themes (Farm Animals this year!), including basic conversational skills and fun, new vocabulary. Cultural awareness, arts and crafts, and a bit of dancing (if you'd like) will be additional points of exploration.

Songs to Enhance Literacy (Grades: 1-2): No Cost

Description: Students will sing different child-friendly songs and talk about the vocabulary in the songs. By the end of the session, students will be able to incorporate new words they have learned and write their very own song. The non-threatening nature of the course will allow students to experiment with language and grow as writers.

Sports Camp (Grades: 2-3 & 4-5): No Cost

Description: Students are taught physical, nutritional and safety components of organized and recreational sports. This course will have an emphasis on fair play and good sportsmanship.

Tech Tools (Grades: 2-3 & 4-5): No Cost

Description: Students will be introduced to and provided the opportunity to explore a variety of technology tools such as iPads, computers, cameras, voice recorders, and card readers. These tools will then be used to create several multimedia projects.

Wonderful World of Words (Grades: K-2 & 3-5): No Cost

Description: **This is also a literacy open registration class!** Through stories, videos, crafts, games, technology, and more, students will learn and practice vocabulary words that are essential for school success. "General academic vocabulary" includes those words that students frequently encounter in school. Fun figurative language and word-learning strategies will be explored. Students can express their creativity by making their own dictionaries and word games. Also, each student will receive a grade specific list of essential academic vocabulary, so learning can continue over the summer. Come join us, and see how much fun words can be!

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Please note: GMS and HMS will be offering a “**Transition to Middle School**” class to incoming 5th grade students. The class will be held in each respective building in August with dates to be announced. There will be more details to follow from your child’s elementary school counselors in April. They will send a Skylert with information this Spring. Please contact them directly if you have questions. This class is not required, it is in addition to the transition support your student will be offered during May during the end of their 4th grade experience.

Entering 6-9 Class Descriptions

Art Exploration (Grades: 6-9): Cost \$10

Description: Students will explore self-expression through the visual arts using a variety of mediums. Student will express their thoughts and feelings through their artistic creations.

Coding and Computer Science 1 (Grades: 6-8): No Cost

Description: Students will learn computer science and coding skills in a fun, collaborative, and creative environment that emphasizes risk-taking and perseverance in solving problems. Students will also use coding language and gamified online resources to create and share their own unique interactive games, quizzes, animations, and applications. *Using their own devices, laptops, tablets, Smart phones, and HASD iPads and computers, students will complete the following: Access educational apps, Web sites, and games; Consume digital media and publish digital content; Learn computer science and coding skills using gamified resources; Share their unique designs and improve communication skills; Engage in creative, innovative, and collaborative digital activities.

ADVANCED--Coding and Computer Science 2 (Grades: 7-9): Students must have taken Coding 1 before enrolling in this class

Description: Students will continue to learn computer science and coding skills in a fun, collaborative, and creative environment that emphasizes risk-taking and perseverance in solving problems and engage in many of the same learning targets and lessons as the Coding and Computer Science for Kids 1. However, with this class, we will take your knowledge and build upon your previous experience. This is a more advanced computer science class and students need to have previously taken Coding and Computer Science for Kids 1 last summer.

CSI (Grades: 7-9): No Cost

Description: Whodunit? Are you science savvy, naturally curious, and have a mind for analytics? If so, you will find this course fascinating! Throughout this course, you will have a hands-on inquiry-based depth of crime scene investigation. Together, we will learn and apply skills to unravel mysteries as you conduct investigations and build a body of evidence. These tasks will assist you in analyzing a crime scene as well as exploring potential careers options. After learning various skills, you will develop your very own mystery for others to solve.

Create and Explode Science (Grades: 6-8): Cost \$5

Description: This summer, learn some of the basic principles of candy, design, and rocketry. TASTE science by creating your own candy and ice cream. Build and CREATE bridges and other contraptions to solve problems. Finally, create EXPLOSIONS in this class by learning to build and launch several types of rockets while competing to be the most accurate.

Golf 101 (Grades: 6-9): Cost \$10

Description: Students will be introduced to the game of golf and all of the challenges and enjoyment it has to offer. Students will learn about the equipment used including differences in club selection, basic rules of golf, proper golf etiquette, and swing instruction. Students will be taught about the different types of shots and scenarios they might encounter during a round of golf. Upon completing their instructional practice, students will spend several days at a local golf course completing a round of golf.

Math for Success (Grades: 6-7 & 8-9): No Cost (Referral Needed)

*****These classes will be given to students having teacher or math interventionist recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis***

Description: This class will focus on grade level specific skills that align with the standards that are taught during the regular school year. Emphasis will be on Math facts and application in real world situations including using math concepts creatively. Teachers will adjust instruction to meet each child's math skills.

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Reading for Success (Grades: 6-7 & 8-9) (Referral Only): No Cost (Referral Needed)

*****This class will be given to students having teacher and***

reading coaches recommendations. Any remaining openings will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis

Description: Emphasis will be placed upon individual student's reading skills and needs focusing on the goal of improving reading ability and self-confidence using more targeted and guided instruction. A variety of activities such as Reader's Theater, Literature Circles and writing will be used to help students enjoy the literature they will be sharing.
