Story Elements:

- 1. Plot The pattern of events that happens in a book, movie, or story
- 2. **Conflict** The *MAIN* problem or challenge faced in a story
- 3. **Climax** The point in a story in which the main conflict is addressed; the event that brings about the solution to the main conflict
- 4. **Rising Action –** Events in a story that lead up to the climax
- 5. **Exposition** The introduction of a story that explains the characters and setting (provides background)
- 6. **Setting** Where (inside, outside, real or fictional locations) a story takes place, the time of day, year (past, present, or future)
- 7. **Resolution** how a conflict works out or is resolved
- 8. **Point of View** who is telling the story: 1st person A person in the story is telling the story ("I went...we flew...for me"); 3rd person the story is told by a narrator; 2nd person the narrator speaks directly to the reader.
- 9. **Falling Action** the ending of the story that happens after the climax
- 10. **Protagonist** the main character who the story is about when the conflict is faced from their perspective
- 11. Antagonist the opposing person who conflicts with the protagonist
