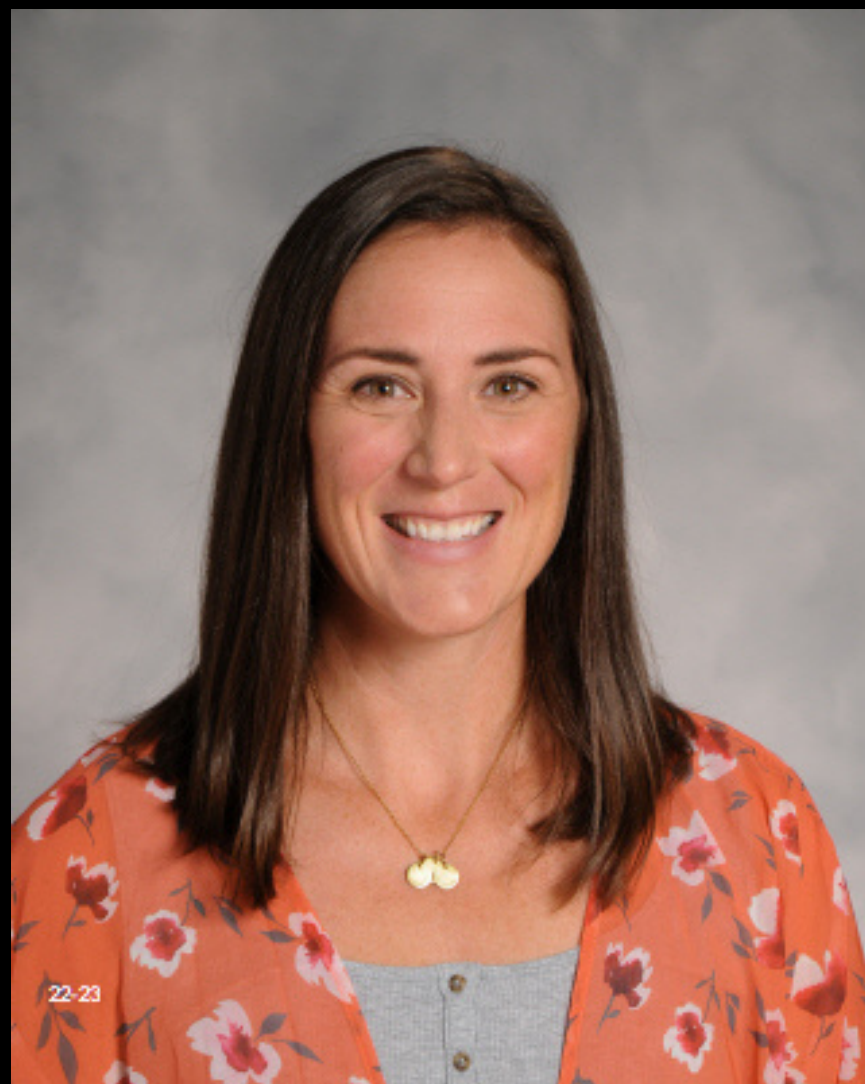

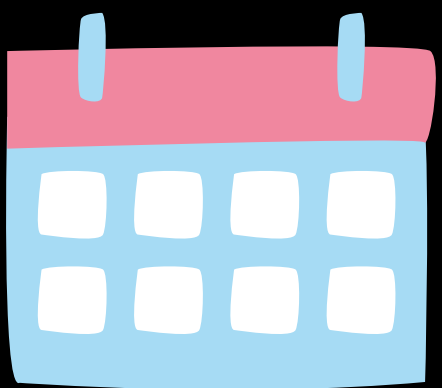

30-45 minutes in length

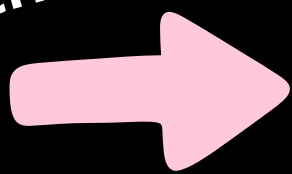
Begin on Oct. 1 (and go through mid-December)

## **START COLLEGE NOW (FVTC)**

**A program designed to introduce high school students to the world of higher education by taking classes at FVTC**

## **EARLY COLLEGE CREDIT PROGRAM (UW SYSTEM)**

**allows high school students take courses at a 4-year public OR private university**



**Students can earn both high school and college credit at the same time, paid for by HASD!**

**These credits may be applied toward a degree at a respective institution or at many other Wisconsin colleges.**



# Start College Now / Early College Credit Programs

- Applications are required to be filled out **EACH SEMESTER** that classes are taken

- **March 1**: Application deadline for the following **FALL** semester

- **October 1**: Application deadline for the following **SPRING** semester

***\*Late applications will NOT be accepted!***
