





PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY



Junior or Senior At least 16 years old



Able to work 10-20 hours per week



On track for graduation and passing classes



Reliable transportation or ability to get to work



JOBSITE HOURS

One Year 450 hours Two Years 900 hours

- These are the minimum required hours
- On average 13-15 hours a week
- Summer hours can be included (200 per year)
- Release time, before/after school, weekend hours available



CLASSROOM HOURS

One Year

1 HS Credit

3 College Credits

Two Years

2 HS Credits

6 College Credits

- Must take concurrent related instruction
- Must maintain passing grades
- Courses at high school, tech college, or industry training

Phase 1: Submit YA Application (January - March)

Phase 2: Leg-Work Phase (March - September)
*You search, network and email businesses to find opportunities.

Phase 3: Interview (April-September)

Phase 4: Hired for the YA Position? You are not guaranteed that you will receive a YA position, even if you fill out an application.



Colleges do NOT require students to take both the SAT and ACT! HHS students will take the ACT their Junior year at the high school.





