Art I provides a foundation for visual design and creation. In this class you will explore different medias and build skills in drawing, color, painting, clay, and printmaking; while incorporating the Elements and Principles of Design. Students will practice their speaking skills by presenting their works in class during a critique.

After the successful completion of Art I, students may take: Art Metals I, Drawing I, Ceramics I, Printmaking, Fibers, and Sculpture. **All art department classes are one semester in length.**
