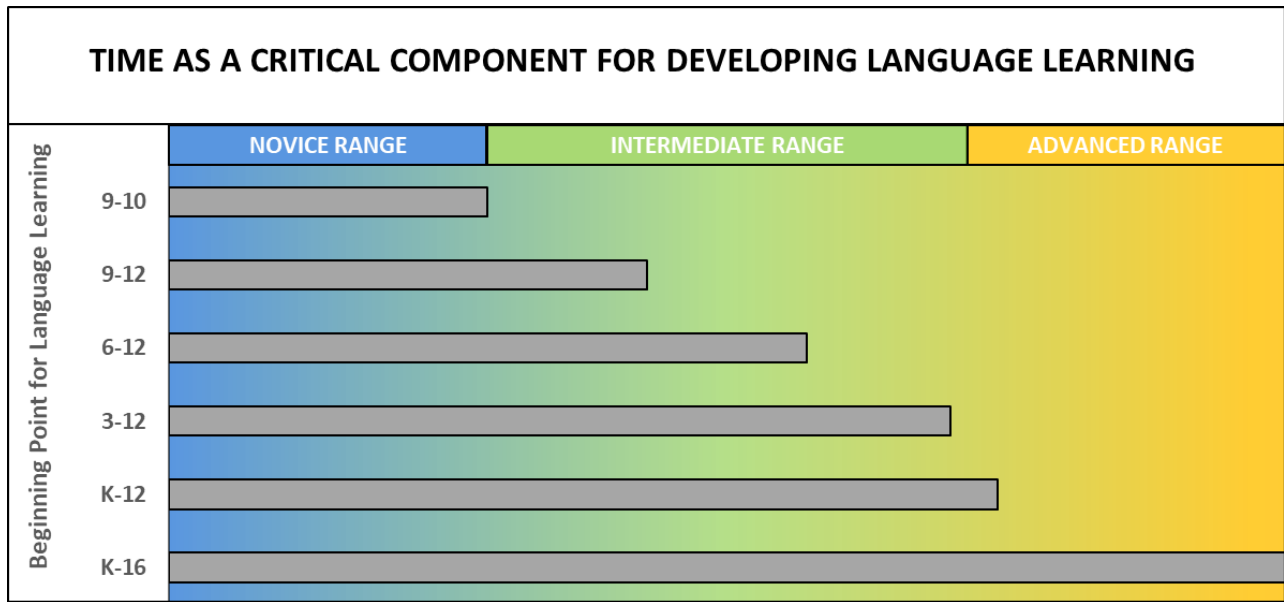


WORLD LANGUAGE

The world language curriculum develops an understanding of the language, culture, history and literature of Spanish and German speaking countries. Spanish and German courses strive to develop student proficiency in reading, writing, listening and speaking the target language as advocated by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages.

*Two to four years of a world language may be required for admission to some universities.
