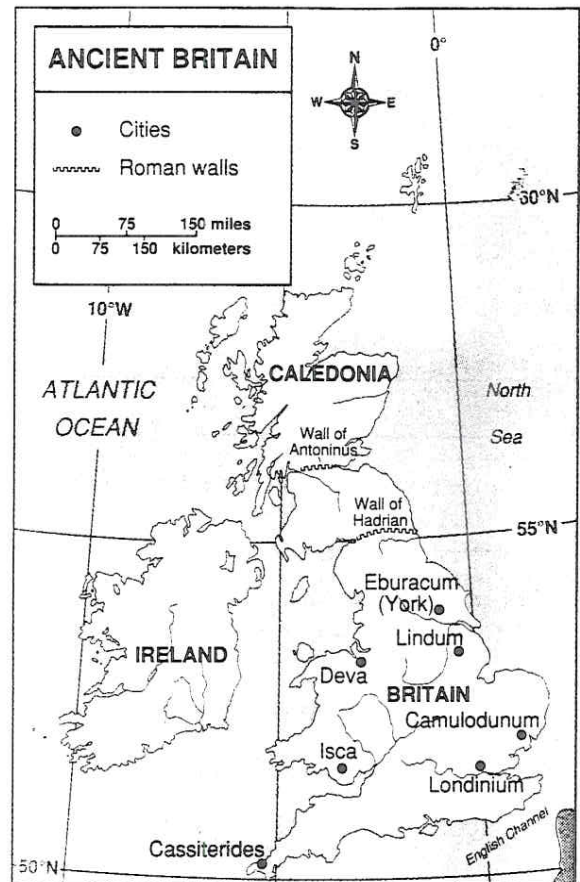


# INTERPRETING A MAP OF ANCIENT BRITAIN

\* In 55 B.C., the Roman conqueror Julius Caesar landed in Britain to prevent the British from helping the Gauls, who were at war with Rome. Caesar returned to Britain the following year, but he never conquered it. A century later, portions of the island were seized by the Roman emperor Claudius I. By A.D. 85, Rome possessed most of Britain. The map shows Britain in A.D. 85. Study the map, and then answer each question by writing the letter of the correct choice in the blank.

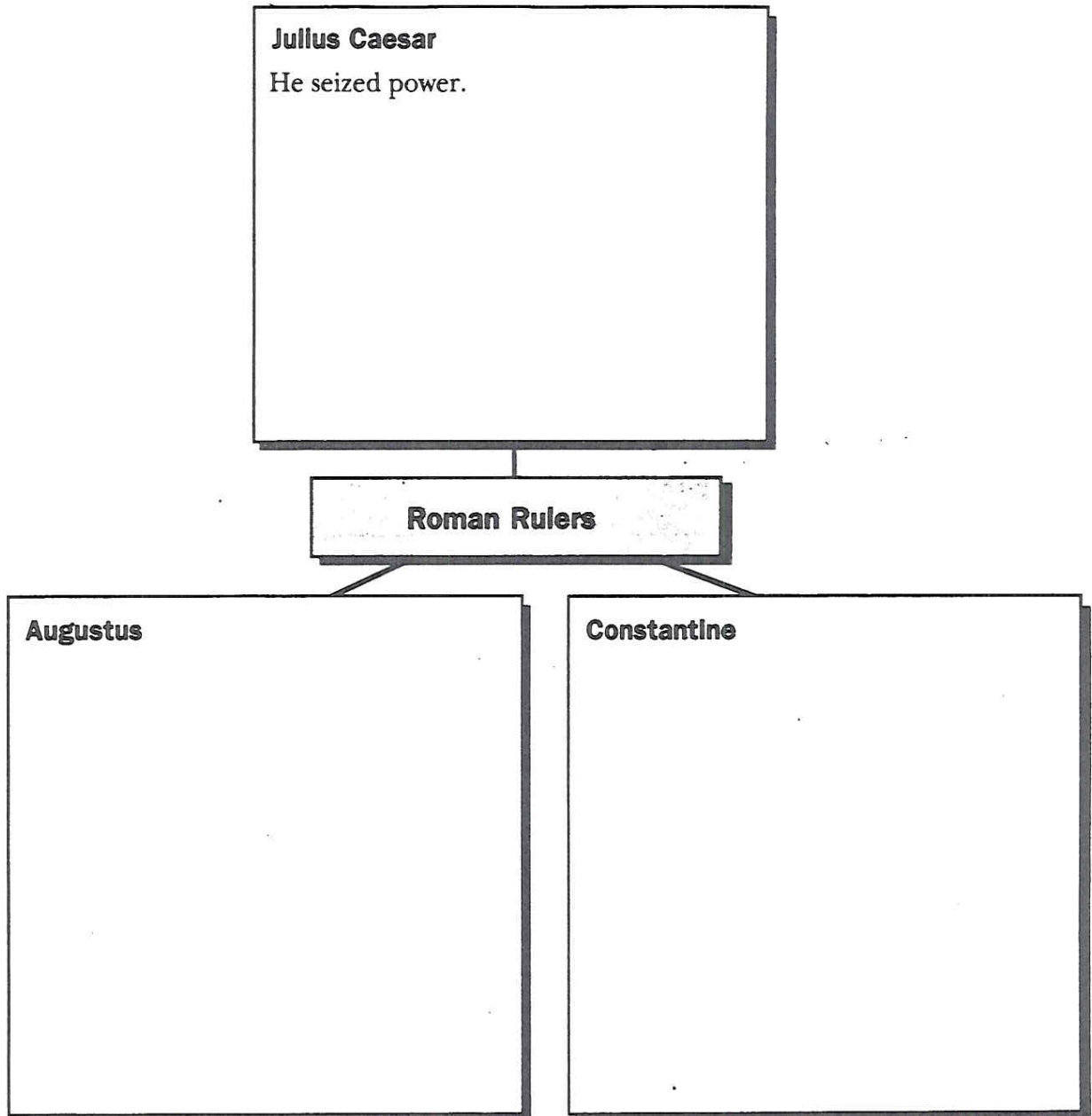
