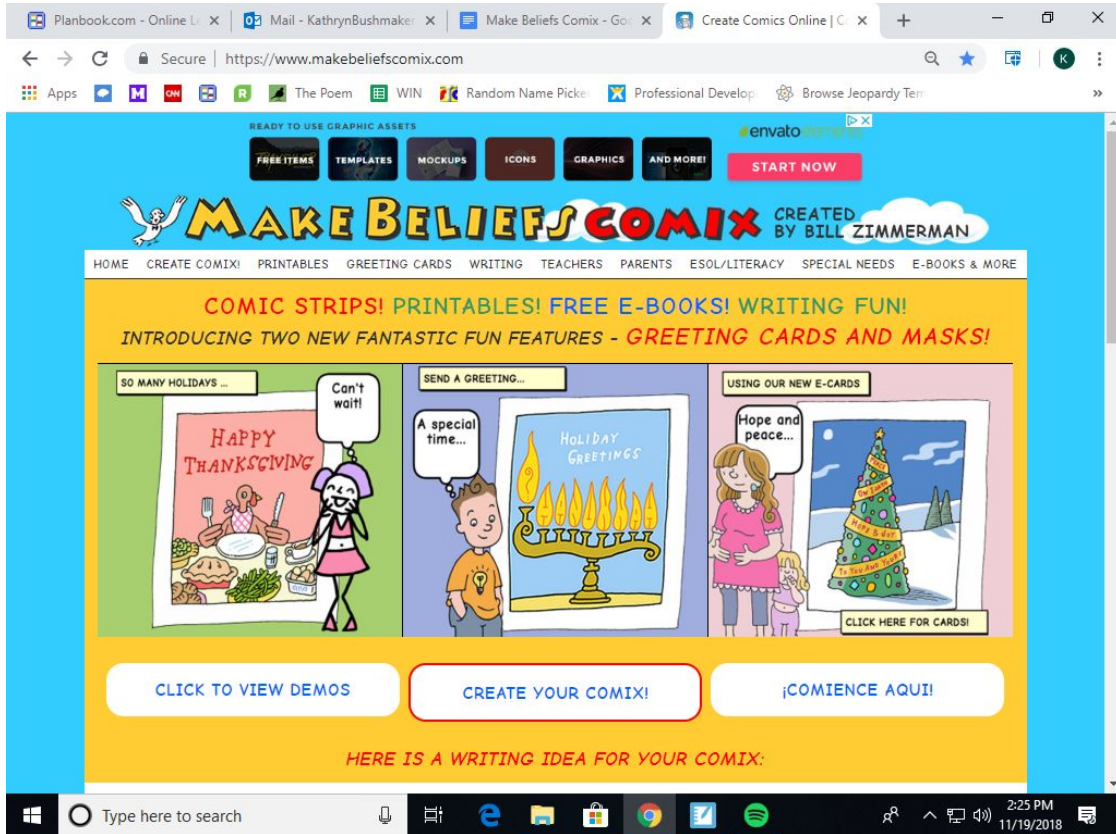


1. Go to www.makebeliefscomix.com and click on Create Comic



2. Type in the title of your comic and also your name in the author's name.



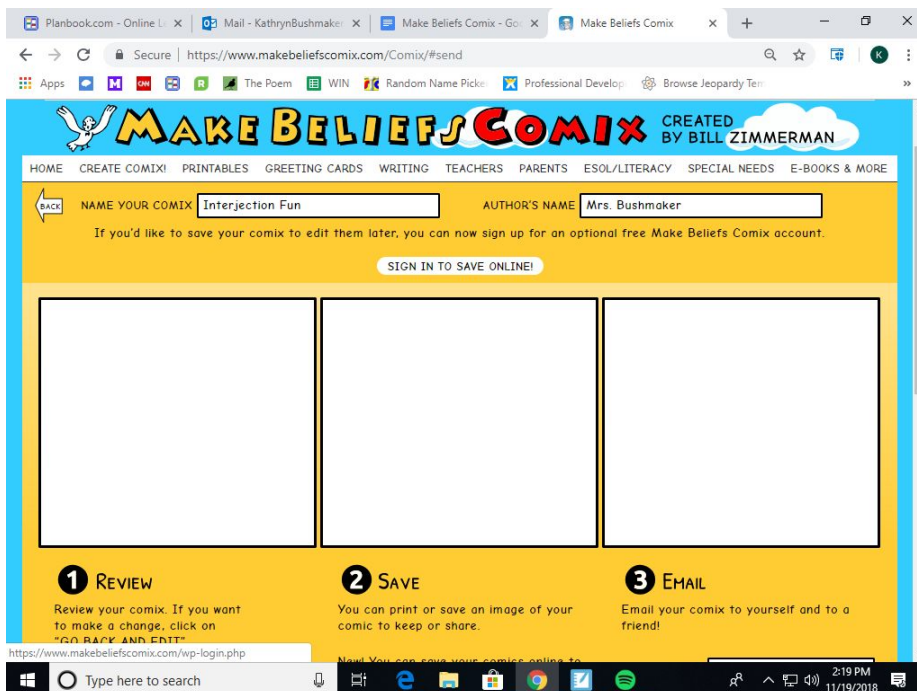
3. Use the icons on the bottom to choose your characters, speech bubbles, backgrounds and more. You may make up to 9 panels.

4. Click the + button to make more panels appear.

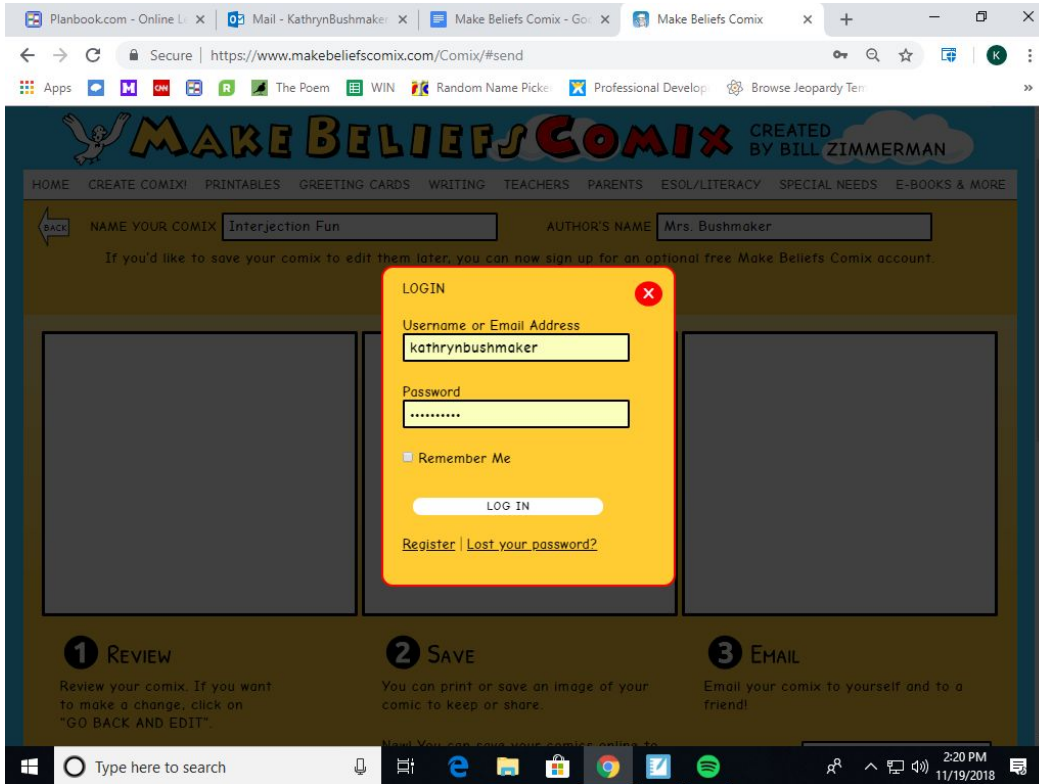
5. When you are done creating your comic strip, you need to save it. **Click Save**



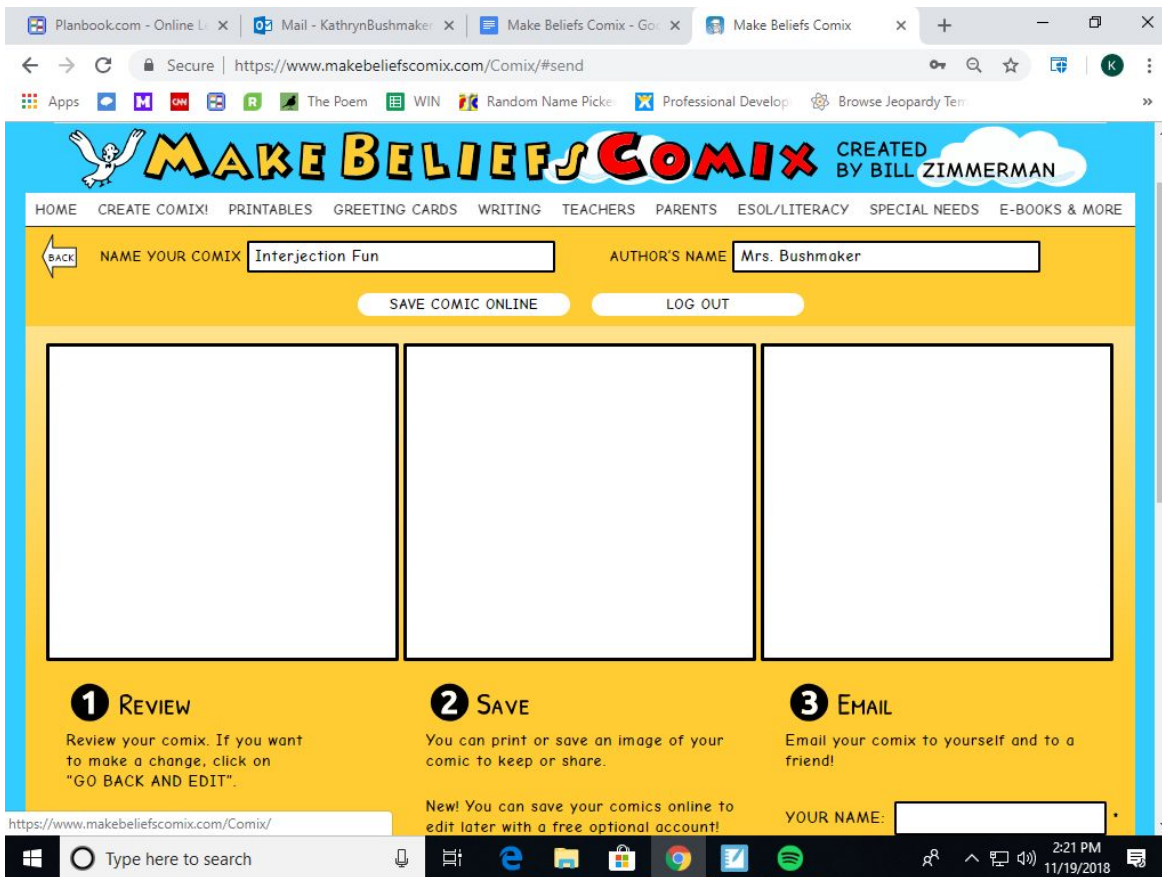
6. After you click "Save" you will get this screen: **Click on Sign in to save online**



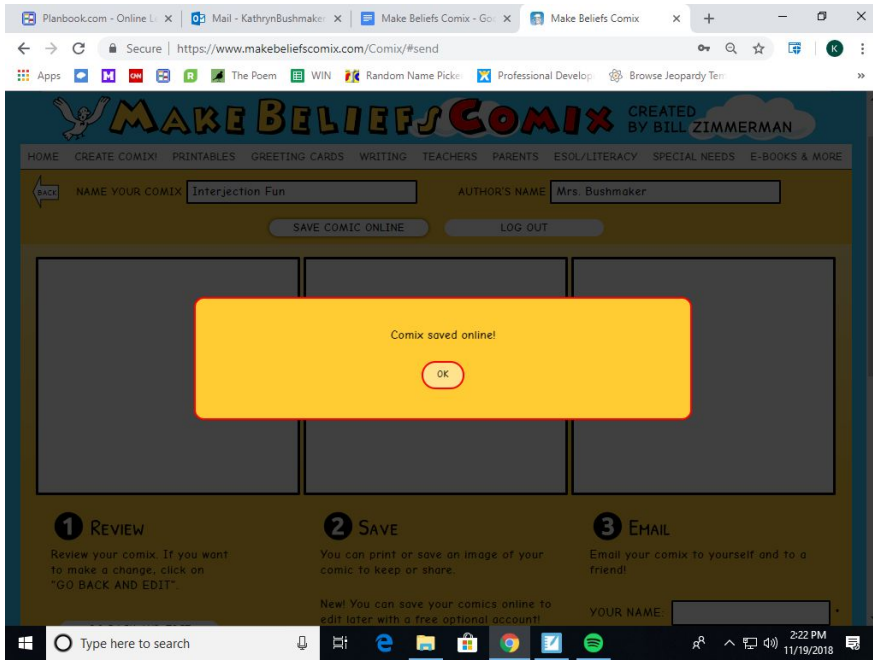
7. Sign-in using this information: Username: kathrynbushmaker Password: polarbears



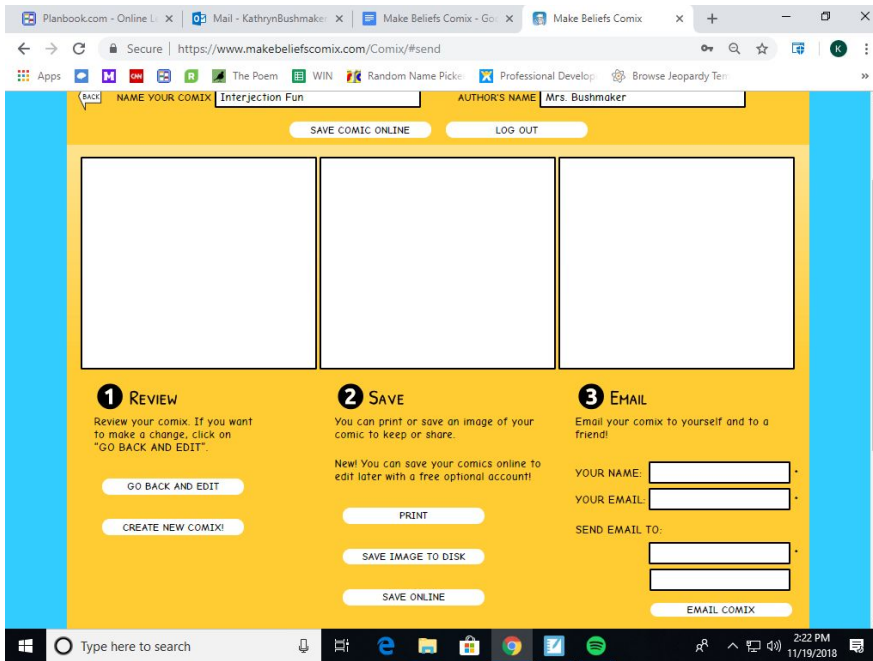
8. Then click on "Save Comic Online"
