

ACABAR + DE + INFINITIVO

Earlier this year we learned two different 3-part structures that take things we already know, combine them and allow us to communicate something new.

First we learned **tener** + **que** + **inf.** = **"hafta"** (and we review it in this unit)

Then we learned **ir** + **a** + **inf.** = **"gonna"**
(and we review it in this unit)

In this unit we encounter our third and final 3-part structure. It is:

acabar de inf. = **to have just...**

Acabar is a regular -ar verb, so it is easy to conjugate. (FYI, it is rarely used outside of this structure.)

ar	
ACABAR = to have just...	
acabo	acabamos
acabas	acabáis
acaba	acaban

Ejemplos:

- I just ran. (Yo) Acabo de correr.
- We just saw a movie. Acabamos de ver una película.
- You just arrived (llegar) Acabas de llegar.
- They just left. (Ellos) Acaban de salir.
