
conjugation you must do!

A few important definitions....

a VERB in its -ar, -er or -ir form, def'n begins w/ "to"

-conjugation: changing an infinitive so it "goes with" the subject (or subject pronoun)

Remember...




## So, how do I do this \*conjugation\* thing???

## Steps for Conjugating Verbs



🖈 put the "stem" in every room

🖈 add "furniture" for every room



## Key things to remember:

A subject or subject pronoun CANNOT be immediately followed by an infinitive.

EVERY regular verb in the Spanish language will follow this conjugation pattern (the 3 steps).

EVERY regular <u>-AR</u> verb in the Spanish language will use this furniture pattern (endings).
