

posesión → de



In English, we use an 's to indicate that something belongs to someone.

However, 's does not exist in Spanish!

Instead, to show ownership in Spanish one must use the preposition de.

The **de** is placed between the noun and the person's name or subject pronoun.

Look at the examples to guide you in writing your own statements. Say to whom each clothing item belongs.

<u>Modelos:</u>	Margarita's 	la camiseta <u>de</u> Margarita
	David's 	los mitones <u>de</u> David
