

GUSTAR (parte 1)

We used **ME GUSTA + INFINITIVE** earlier this year to say that we like to do various activities. Ejemplos: *Me gusta cantar.* / *No me gusta nadar.*

Now we'll learn to use **GUSTAR with nouns** to express our opinions about clothing.

There are actually TWO ways to say "I LIKE..." **ME GUSTA...** and **ME GUSTAN**



HUH?! *Let's take a closer look....*

Loosely translated, "*Me gusta la falda.*" means I like the skirt.

More precisely though, the actual meaning of "*Me gusta la falda.*" is

The skirt is pleasing to me.

Therefore, if you like something that is plural, like *los calcetines*, you need to say

Me gustan *los calcetines*, which technically means

The socks ARE pleasing to me.
