How do I know if a noun is singular or plural? 😊 **EASY!** Plural nouns end in - S.

To make a singular noun plural.....

- If a noun ends in a vowel, you make it plural simply by adding s.
- If a noun ends in a consonant, you make it plural by adding es.
- If a noun ends in a Z, you must first change the Z to a C, and then add es.
- If a noun ends in -án, -én, -ín, -ón, or -ún, **remove** the written accent, then add **es**.
- If a singular noun ends -s, do **NOT** change the noun. **ONLY** the article is made plural.
