EL PRETÉRITO (parte 3): -ER and -IR Verbs in the Preterit Tense



I can conjugate the preterite tense to express *completed actions in the past*.

For verbs that end in:

-aer

-eer

-oír

-oer

leí	leímos
leíste	leísteis
leyó	leyeron

él/ella/usted = use the ending "yó" (rather than ió) ellos/
ellas/ustedes = uses the ending "yeron" (rather than ieron)

The remaining forms gain a written accent over the letter "i."
