Welcome:

Singing Valentines:

Friday, February 14th students who pass their readiness check will be allowed to sing for other students on Valentine's Day. The sign up has been in class for the past week and a half. Readiness Checks will be any time during the week of February 3rd. The selections must have a small group performing and all music must be live, no use of recordings allowed. Songs should be limited to not more than 3 minutes.

The following Monday the same students will have the opportunity to sing at The Opera House in Hortonville for a senior luncheon. We will depart the high school at 11:15 and return around 12:15.

Solo and Ensemble:

Registration is now closed for Solo and Ensemble. The festival will take place in Seymour on Saturday, February 29th. Accompanists are schedule to be in the week of February 17th to work with the students. Once we have a schedule from Seymour I will share that with parents and students.

Lessons:

All students have been assigned their weekly lesson. These are to start Monday, February 3rd. The lesson schedule is posted both inside and outside the choir room. We also reviewed lesson times in class. I encouraged all students to set a reminder in the phone for 5 minutes before their scheduled start time so they can be here ready to sing. All students should be coming out of Academic Extension, Commons, an extended period or out of Arctic Singers.

Senior Recital:

Seniors will have the option to perform 2-3 selections during a senior recital on Friday, March 13th. Students can sing selections from their past Solo and Ensemble experiences as well as Vocal Jazz or original compositions. This is a great opportunity to show off the skills you have gained throughout your high school career. More details will be released in the coming weeks.
