<u>Math Corner</u>

We wrapped up our fractions unit this week. The students learned SOOO much. If you haven't seen your child's final assessment yet, ask them about it.

We are working on learning about area again this week. Specifically we looked at irregular shapes.

Next week we will be into our data unit. We will learn about collecting data, organizing into graphs and charts and then using data to solve problems.

Two other things to be doing at home to help your child in math...

1. Practice multiplication facts (Checks are on Thursdays. Your child SHOULD be bringing home their envelope of facts nightly. The goal is that ALL third graders have mastered all facts through x9 by the end of the school year.)

2. Use Dreambox on the computer or tablet.

(If your child gets screen time anyway, this would be a great way to use it! ;)



Reader's Workshop

In reader's workshop we have been learning about author's message and point of view within nonfiction texts. We also started a biography genre study. We have already read about lots of interesting people throughout history.

Writer's Workshop

We are wrapping up our opinion writing unit this week. The students have grown A LOT as persuasive writers. They are sharing their pieces as speeches with the class. After break I will be sending home their realistic fiction stories and their opinion pieces for you to read.

After break we will be going into an informational writing unit. Students will choose topics to learn about that interest them.
