Race for \$1



This is a game for two or more people. The object is to be the first person to get enough coins to trade in for the \$1 bill. It's fine to have extra coins, but you must have at least \$1.

To play, you need two dice, a \$1 bill, and lots of coins (25-30 pennies, 5-10 nickels, 5-10 dimes, 2-3 quarters). Set the dollar bill aside. Put all the coins in a pile. Everyone should take turns.

- 1. On your turn, roll the dice. The sum tells you how much to take from the coin pile.
- 2. You can also use your turn to exchange some of your coins. (10 pennies for 1 dime, 2 dimes and 1 nickel for a quarter, etc.)
- 3. Give the dice to the next player and follow the same rules.
- 4. Play until one player has enough to exchange for the \$1 bill.

Remember:

You may only exchange (or "play trade") when it's your turn. Watch to make sure you agree with what the other players do.
