four, three, two, one, BLAST OFF!

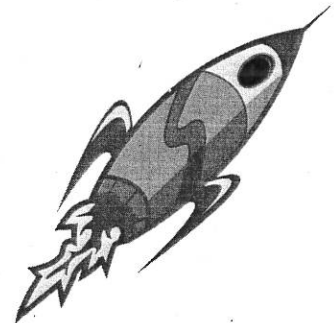
*(sing)*

'Cause I'll be lookin' at you.

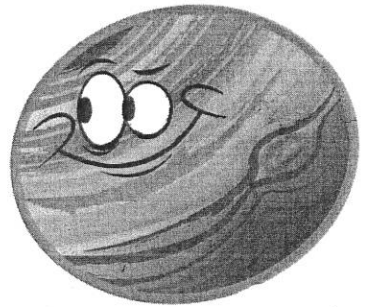

ending with Pluto)*

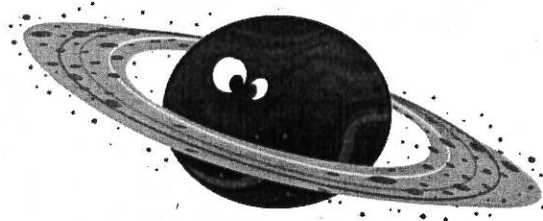
Last Refrain
