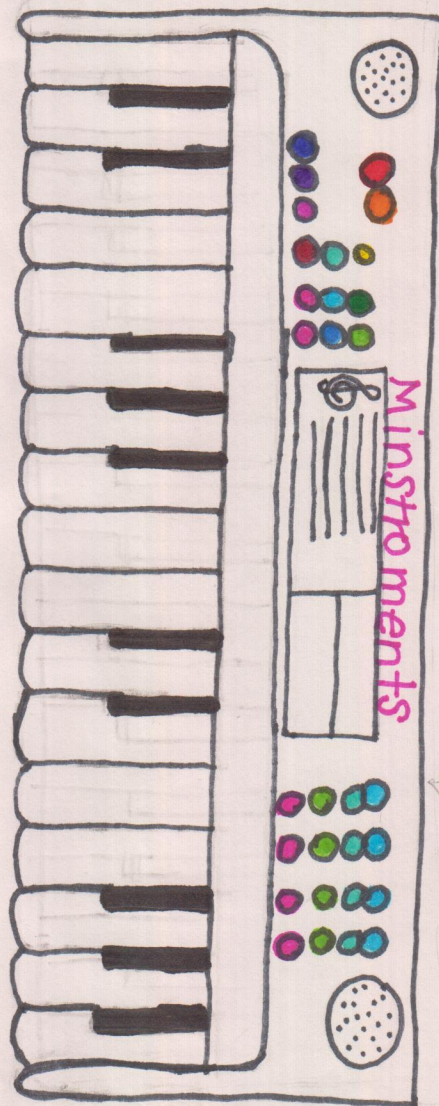

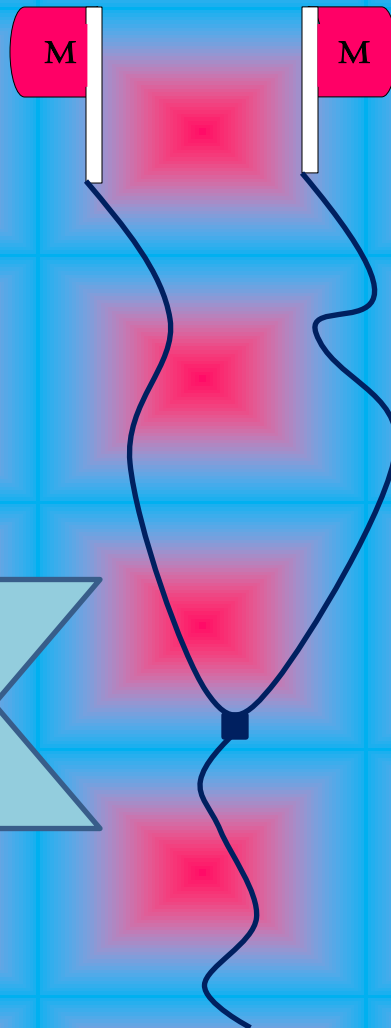

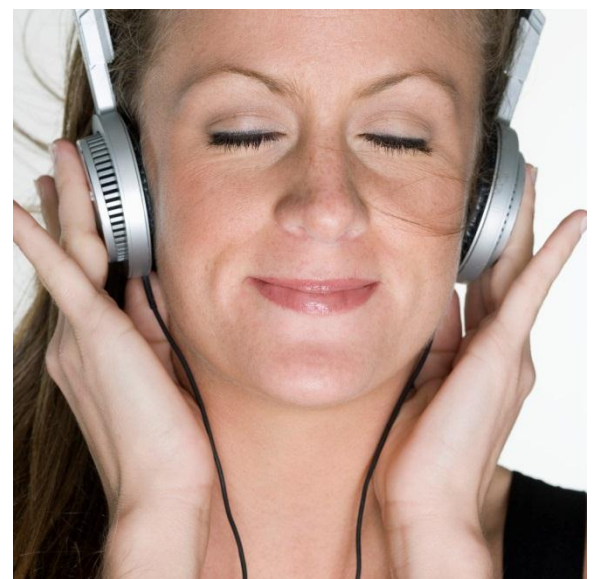


## Types of Music

everywhere that's why they cause drama sometimes. They just can't take the pressure.



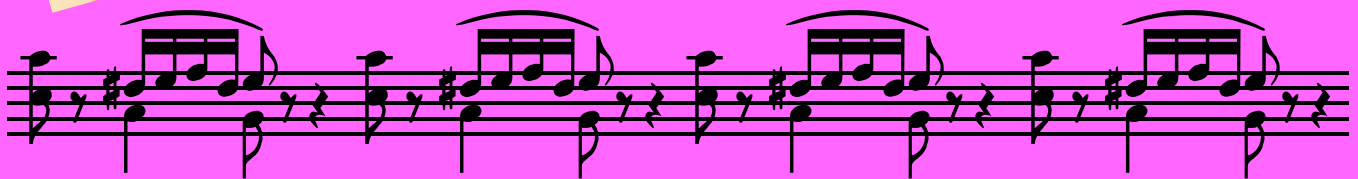

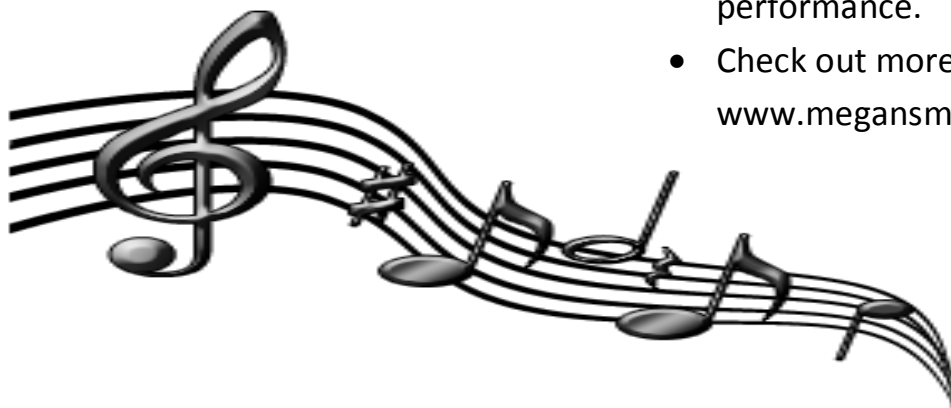
