Labrador Retriever

Labrador Retrievers are a species of a dog, as you all probably know. The Lab is a hunting dog, also known as a Retrieving Dog.



This dog originated in Newfoundland, Canada and was first called the St. John's Water Dog. The first St. John's dog was said to have been brought to England

around 1820. There is a story that the Earl of Malmesbury saw a St. John's Dog on a fishing boat and right away made arrangements with traders to have some of these dogs exported to England. From there the dogs popularity grew and their name was changed to be named after the geographic area known as "the Labrador"--they were then known as Labrador Retrievers because they "retrieved" in the Labrador sea

Labrador's can be in different colors such as yellow, white, red, brown, silver, and black. Their eyes can be brown or blue and their tails are long and fluffy.

A retriever is a great swimming dog, because of their webbed feet that act as propellers when they swim. Their tail acts like a rudder in water, the tail is like an otter tail. They also have a slightly oily coat that lets them dry quickly and insulates them.

Labrador's can weigh 27-35 kg as a female adult and can be as tall as 57 cm. A male adult lab can weigh 29-36 kg and hard. Labs need to be taken on walks and exercise daily. They also love to run along

can also be as tall as 63 cm. This breed of dog has a lifespan of 10-12 years.

A labrador is one of the most popular breeds in the USA, because of how loyal and passionate they are to their owners. Labs are also very loving, affectionate and patient. These personalities help make a very good family dog. Labradors are highly intelligent, good natured, very willing and eager to please. Labs love to play, especially in water, they never want to pass up a good swim. Retrievers have an excellent, reliable temperament, and are friendly. They work superb with children and can also work well with other dogs.

Grooming a labrador retriever is not very hard Comb and brush them regularly with a firm, bristle brush, paying attention to the undercoat. Bathe or dry shampoo only when necessary. These dogs are very high shedders. The breed tends to shed their hair twice a year while some can shed year round depending on the temperature.



A labrador can get many different health problems. Some of the main ones are Hip and Elbow Dysplasia, mast cell tumors, eye diseases, OCD (Osteochondritis Dissecans), Cataracts,
